What is NHI?

The goal of the National Hispanic Institute is to develop young people into the valued thinkers and doers of an exciting, rapidly emerging Latino world. Every year, the National Hispanic Institute conducts a search in the United States and Latin America for the brightest and most talented students who are willing to answer the call to leadership in the global Latino community. What distinguishes the NHI experience is that it is a live learning lab for advanced social development focused on executive leadership. All leadership coaches in NHI programs are former program participants, including the adult directors whose role is to provide structure and guidance in the learning process. In the end, everyone has to run a mental marathon and is exhausted from the high volume of late-night discussions, readings, writings, and decision-making. We all realize that the NHI learning experience happens at multiple levels, from the students to the coaches, and from the program specialists to the adult directors.



The Great Debate

High School Freshmen participate in a program known as the Great Debate. With three sites, this communications enhancement experience brings together students from all major regions of the US and a few Latin American countries.

Participants spend a week on a college campus challenging themselves in the areas of critical thinking, though expression, and learning skills that will make them successful in highly intense, competitive environments. Through this program, they are also exposed and familiarized with some of the most pertinent issues facing in the Latino Community in the 21st century.

LDZ

The Lorenzo De Zavala Youth Legislative Session is the widely known high school program that NHI offers. Students, either in their sophomore or junior year, are able to participate in a mock legislative program that is geared towards guiding the participants to learn to create individual ideas and navigate through systems to reach their individual goals while learning to build relationships and operate the protocols of formal decision-making.

Only 1000 openings are available and the pool to select from is 400 private and public high schools.

CWS

The Collegiate World Series is designed as a learning experience in personal leadership that provides insight and guidance to NHI high school alumni who are transitioning to college as emerging high school seniors. Students sharpen learning, increase comprehension, and develop views that help them create balance between professional and community calling.

The CWS provides students with the fundamental means of making key distinctions in their life work, using imagination and inventiveness as tools to consider different pathways of achieving significance in the mission of changing lives.
